Who We Are

The Choice to Change (C2C) was founded by Eva Kernova and Sunil Baroi in July 2010. C2C was endorsed as an official foundation by the government of Bangladesh in March 2013; **Reg No. S-11649**.

Our Vision: is to educate 500 underprivileged children from the slums of Dhaka. Furthermore, C2C desires to attain a world-renowned status, allowing the foundation to open additional schools internationally.



What We Do

Two Schools: Located in the slum communities of Khilkhet and Lalmati, in Bangladesh's capital city, Dhaka. We provide primary education, uniforms, school bags, books, stationery, basic medical care, a daily breakfast, and occasional meals at lunch time.

Grades: 2 Nursery (age 4-5 years), 2 Kindergarten (age 5-6 years), 2 Standard-1 (age 6-8 years), 2 Standard-2 (age 7-10 years)

Curriculum: English, Bangla, Math, Environmental Science, Art, General Knowledge, Islamic Studies, Computers, Health & Hygiene

Provisions: Slum Cleaning; Donations (clothes & toys); Doctor Visits

In the Pipeline: C2C Sustainability Projects; Community Awareness Campaigns (hygiene, family planning, negative effects of tobacco, etc.); Poverty Alleviation Projects for student's families.
